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## ART SPECIALIST NEWS

We are off to a great start in art! Students are designing their portfolio cover and learning art room routines. It's been a joy to see returning students and meet new ones. If you are new to Cedar River, I wanted to take this opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Mrs. Henninger, and I am the art specialist at Cedar River. I also teach coding (K-4), and robotics (5th), starting at the end of January. This is my seventh-year teaching for Tahoma.

I see each class once a week. As we make art together, we explore the seven elements of art: line, shape, form, texture, color, value and space. Students use a variety of mediums including watercolors, tempera paint, oil and chalk pastels, as well as other dry mediums.

Students are graded on participation in art. Participation includes trying the projects, putting forth their best effort, listening and following directions, and showing the O3's (making good decisions, solving problems, and showing respect.) Art projects are saved in student portfolios here at school. Students bring their art portfolio home at the end of the semester, before we dive into coding and robotics.

I am so excited for the year ahead and look forward to starting our first project next week! Please reach out if you have any questions or concerns.
