### Hello Otter Families!

# **Call For Students**

Do you have or know of a Tahoma 4- or 5-year-old child not currently attending preschool? We are making a "Call for Students" for our federally-funded, full-day Transition to Kindergarten (TK) program starting in January.

To be eligible for Transition to Kindergarten, children must:

- be 5 years old on or before August 31, 2024
- live within the boundaries of Tahoma School District
- not be currently enrolled in an early learning program
- demonstrate academic and/or social-emotional needs through a screening process
