Dear Otter Families,

It's hard to believe it is already December. Earlier this week our students got to attend a Taproot Theatre presentation. The Taproot Theatre Company produces plays around topics such as friendship and bullying. All students in our school had the opportunity to view the play, *The Friend Ship*. I'm sharing some of the questions below that you might want to use to engage your child in conversations around the play's themes:

- 1. What parts of the play did you like the best? Were there parts that made you think more than others? Were there things in the play that surprised you?
- 2. What characters did you like best and what characters did you not like, and why? Who did you identify with?
- 3. What is bullying? What is cyberbullying?
- 4. What should you do when you see someone getting bullied?

We are grateful for your partnership as we work together to help our students not only identify unkind behaviors, but to also acquire a greater sense of empathy for others. Empathy and kindness are attributes that are helpful in building positive and lasting relationships. Thank you for your support as we work to promote these in our community.


