Here's what's happening in music:

Fifth graders have been celebrating Black History Month by spotlighting unique performers from that community. A highlight was listening to Bobby McFarrin's "Don't Worry Be Happy."

Fourth Graders have been working very hard to prepare for their concert next Thursday, February 15th. All are welcome!

Third graders have begun preparing for their concert, The High Seas, on Thursday, March 14th. It has been a rollicking fun time singing songs in music!

Second graders are practicing moving with patterns in music. They are learning to match their body movement with sections of music. They are also learning songs for their concert on Wednesday, March 27th (the date was recently changed due to an unforeseen scheduling conflict).

First graders are learning how to use pitches So and Mi and are exploring classroom instruments.

Kindergarteners are learning the rule of instruments in the classroom: If you play before I say, then I have to take away." They have also been working on listening to contrast in music. Scarves and movement help identify what that looks like and sounds like.
