Hello Otter Families!

The daffodil garden is in bloom at CRES, and spring is in the air. Here at school, we continuously emphasize the importance of HOPE. We often see students performing new tasks, making new friends, being a good helper, or experiencing new challenges. These experiences are seen as opportunities to build that sense of self-efficacy and attitude of HOPE through a number of recognition structures. Otter paws are given to individual students when recognized by a staff member reinforcing school and classroom expectations. Weekly on announcements, paws are drawn and students receive a prize. Teachers and staff recognize students monthly with a certificate and picture on our bulletin board as they see future ready skills becoming habit. Whole classrooms are recognized by staff other than their teacher with an Otterly Amazing certificate when the class is seen showing the O3's as they transition throughout the campus. My favorite is when a staff member recognizes a student and I get to make a phone call home to let the parents know about it. All these recognition strategies are ways that we celebrate the growth our students are making both academically, socially, and behaviorally. It is an honor for our staff to work with such wonderful children. Thank you for partnering with us as we work together on behalf of student learning.
