In March, students learned the skills necessary to be a Strategic Problem Solver that included our school-wide Kelso's Choice curriculum.

In April, students will be learning about the Future Ready Skill: Creative Innovator. Additionally, students will be learning about being responsible online through Digital Citizenship lessons.
