#### Coding, Robotics, and Art news!

Greetings Otter families! Kindergarten, first, and second graders are finishing up our coding unit. Kindergarteners practiced moving an animal to its food, and making the food disappear when bumped. First graders coded their own story with dialogue and multiple pages. Second graders made a game with interactive buttons on the screen to

move a character to its target, while avoiding obstacles. If your kiddo is interested in practicing coding at home, <a href="www.code.org">www.code.org</a> and the Scratch Jr. appare both great resources. K-2 will resume creating artistic masterpieces to finish up the school year.

Third graders have a few more coding lessons to go using the Hopscotch coding app. We have learned about events, loops, and conditionals. We coded our own version of Crossy Road, wrote a program to make a star design, and coded an "egg" to turn into a lizard when it reached a certain size.

Fourth graders used tutorials and coding instruction cards to learn how to build programs in Scratch. We are now trying out another block coding app called Tynker.

Fifth graders are currently building grabbers to pick up "litter." Students will explore testing the grabbers and collecting data, an important step in the Engineering Design Process.

The District Art Invitational is coming soon! All are invited to attend on Saturday, May 18th from 4-6pm at the Tahoma High School. Art pieces were selected during the first semester. If your child has a piece that will be featured in the District Art Show, a notice was sent home in their portfolio. Art was also saved to be featured in the Maple Valley Days Art Show in June.
